Fundraiser: UCPC has one fundraiser a year to help with the cost of new toys and learning centers for the preschool. This year we will be selling Rada Cutlery. You will receive a catalog in your child's backpack, please do not go door to door, but ask friends and family to support the fundraiser. Thank you all for your help.

Field Trip: We will have a field trip to the Fulton Fire Station on Friday, October 14. If your child does not normally attend on Friday they may come for the field trip at no extra charge. If your child comes only for preschool you will drop them off at the fire station at 8:30 that morning. I will bring the daycare kids to the fire station in the Unity Christian Van if they are at the center before 8:30, if they arrive after 8:30 please bring them to the fire station. The kids and teachers will ride the fire trucks back to the center when the field trip is over. We will need some parent volunteers, please let me know if you would like to help, the field trip will be from 8:30-10:00.

Tuition Payment: Preschool payments are due the first week of each month. Daycare payments are due weekly / bi-weekly. We accept cash or check, checks can be made out to UCPC.

Extra Set of Clothes: Please check your child's clothes box to make sure they have an extra set of clothes, with the weather changing you may need to change out summer clothes with fall clothes.

Sick: If your child is not feeling well please keep them home. They may not attend if they have a fever, diarrhea, or vomiting in the past 24 hours. They must be symptom free without medication for 24 hours before returning to school.

Looking Ahead:

- We will have Harvest Parties on October 18 & 19 for our preschool room and October 19 for our PreK room. (We do not celebrate Halloween, we will celebrate fall with Harvest Parties)
- We will have a Fall Break Oct. 24 - 28, we will not have preschool that week, daycare will be open.
