This agreement between athlete, family and the athletic boosters states that you understand the importance of fundraising participation which supports and promotes our athletic programs. Our boosters strive to provide quality programs by raising funds to cover the \$30,000+ budget. Without your participation in our **selling** and **service** fundraising opportunities this would not be possible. Our fundraising opportunities include **both selling and serving** fundraisers.

Selling will take place in the fall (wreath/poinsettia sales) and spring (pizzas)(subject to change)

All 5-12th grade athletes are **encouraged** to participate in our fall and spring selling fundraising

High school students have a \$120 profit goal to reach with our selling fundraisers.

Junior high students playing a varsity sport (boys soccer, girls soccer, boys vb) have a **\$60 profit** goal to reach with our <u>selling</u> fundraisers.

5th-8th students not participating in a varsity have no specific <u>selling</u> goal to reach but are encouraged to participate!

Service opportunities will be working at the tree farm (November/December) and Pizza Ranch Impact Night January 19, 2026.

Students that play a varsity sport will have the opportunity to serve by working 2 shifts. This can be done at the TimberLane Christmas Tree farm and/or Pizza Ranch Impact Night.

Junior High Students that do not participate in a varsity sport are asked to work one shift only.

If an athlete does not meet their fundraising goal of \$60/\$120 they will be asked to pay remaining balance before the end of the school year.	the
